



# RECYCLE

The Township of North Londonderry has set guidelines for storage and handling of municipal waste and recyclable materials. Under these rules and regulations, all commercial haulers or collectors of municipal waste or recyclable material must be licensed by the Greater Lebanon Refuse Authority. In order for these collectors to be licensed, they must agree to abide by the Township and Greater Lebanon Refuse Authority regulations. You may choose any licensed hauler to pick-up your waste and recyclable material, unless you belong to a Homeowner's Association who may have designated one for your area. Contact the [Greater Lebanon Refuse Authority](#) at 717-867-5790 to find out which companies are currently licensed for collection in the Township.

*The following items are designated as recyclable materials and may not be mixed with other trash:*

**Newspapers** - stack in paper grocery bags or tied with string

**Glass Food & Beverage Containers** - rinse, clean and remove lids;  
labels do not need to be removed

**Aluminum Food & Beverage Containers** - rinse and clean

**Bi-metal Food & Beverage Containers** - rinse and clean

**Ferrous Containers (Steel or Tin)** - rinse and clean, remove lids and place inside

**Plastic Food & Beverage Containers (Type #1 & #2 Plastic)** - rinse, remove caps  
**Bottles ONLY (Type #1 through #7 Plastic)** and crush bottles

➤ Commercial establishments are to be recycling the above items as well as their office paper and corrugated cardboard!

➤ If you are interested in recycling an item that has not been addressed, contact your waste hauler or Greater Lebanon Refuse Authority.

- Bulk waste, which may require special handling, shall be collected at least once a year at a time designated by the Authorized Collector, or more frequently as contracted by a customer. Please call your hauler to make arrangements with them for any bulk waste collection.
- If your waste is more of a hazardous nature or you have unwanted electronics, contact the county hotline at 1-800-449-7587 for home pick-up at a small fee. Please use it wisely, pick-ups are limited to each household once a year and other restrictions apply!
- Branches 1” - 3” in diameter trimmed for *routine* maintenance and leaves are collected curbside by the Township. Check out the North Londonderry Township Newsletter for preparation guidelines and times. This is not a daily service.



## COMPOST FACILITY

The Township offers recycling of lawn clippings, leaves, corrugated cardboard and a multitude of other green and brown waste at the compost facility. Dumping privileges are granted at a fee to Township residents only. ### *Key Notes about the Facility:*

Corrugated Cardboard - break down and flatten boxes

Newspapers - unbound and may include inserts

Junk Mail/Mixed Paper – this includes office paper AND paperboard such as cereal boxes

No ground, sod or trash

Items should not be bound, bagged or tied in anyway.

Dumping of unsolicited items will be forwarded to the Police Department, please, read our rules and regulations with care!
