January 3, 2023

The annual organization and regular meeting of the North Londonderry Township Board of Supervisors was called to order at 7:30 p.m. on January 3, 2023 by Chairman Ronald Fouché in the Township Municipal Building. Resolution No. 01-03-2023A (2023 Fee Schedule - Township Equipment) was adopted on motion by Riegler, seconded by Buckfelder. All in favor.

Resolution No. 01-03-2023B (2023 Fee Schedule - Reimburse Engineering Fees) was adopted on motion by Buckfelder, seconded by Riegler. All in favor.

Resolution No. 01-03-2023C (Waive Employee Contributions – Police Pension Plan – Year 2023) was adopted on motion by Riegler, seconded by Buckfelder. All in favor.

On motion by Buckfelder, seconded by Riegler, the Supervisors set the Treasurer's Bond at \$2,000,000 for the year 2023. All in favor.

On motion by Riegler, seconded by Buckfelder, the Supervisors approved the payment of a meeting stipend from the Greater Lebanon Refuse Authority to the Township's representative. All in favor.

On motion by Buckfelder, seconded by Riegler, the Supervisors authorized the payment of bills during the coming year in a timely manner, according to law, and the furnishing of a list at the next regular meeting for Board ratification. All in favor.

Cindy Beam, Resident of Plum Street, was present and requested the Township consider placing more lights at the entrance of the Township facility. Chairman Fouché noted the possibilities will be explored.
