BOARD OF SUPERVISORS

April 17, 2023

The regular meeting of the North Londonderry Township Board of Supervisors was called to order on April 17, 2023, at 7:30 p.m. by Chairman Ronald Fouché in the Township Municipal Building. Present were Supervisors Barry Riegler and William Buckfelder, Solicitor Andrew Morrow, Manager Michael Booth, Assistant Manager Kristopher Troup, Chief Kevin Snyder, and Assistant Secretary/Treasurer Judy Miller. Four visitors were in attendance.

The Chairman called for questions or comments on the agenda items for this meeting. No comments were received.

Minutes from the meeting of April 5, 2023, were approved as presented on motion by Riegler, seconded by Buckfelder. All in favor.

The Treasurer's Report for the period ending March 31, 2023, was accepted as presented.
