

# NORTH LONDONDERRY TOWNSHIP

## BOARD OF SUPERVISORS

December 18, 2023

The regular meeting of the North Londonderry Township Board of Supervisors was called to order at 7:30 p.m. on December 18, 2023 by Chairman Ronald Fouché in the Township Municipal Building. Others attending were Supervisors Barry Riegle and William Buckfelder, Solicitor Andrew Morrow, Manager Michael Booth, and Chief Kevin Snyder. Five (5) visitors were present.

Chairman Fouché called for questions or comments from the public on the agenda items for this meeting. None were received.

Resolution No. 12-18-2023A (2024 Street Light & Fire Hydrant Assessments) was adopted on motion by Riegle, seconded by Buckfelder. All in favor.

Resolution No. 12-18-2023B (Sewer Fee Schedule) was adopted on motion by Buckfelder, seconded by Riegle. All in favor.

On motion by Riegle, seconded by Buckfelder, the final adoption of the 2024 Budget was approved. Chairman Fouché asked for any discussion or questions of the public. No further discussion was held. Final vote was taken. All in favor.

David Yarian, resident of Oatfield Lane asked the Supervisors about the need to repair the water drainage problem at the Lingle Avenue School. Discussion was held and noted PennDOT is responsible for the road.

Deborah Buckfelder, Township Representative – Palmyra Public Library Board submitted a monthly report noting the 2024 Budget is complete and has passed. She also noted the Property Committee met to discuss the future projects and the Annual Fund Drive is doing well. A copy of the report is on file for public viewing.
