

NORTH LONDONDERRY TOWNSHIP

BOARD OF SUPERVISORS

February 20, 2024

The regular meeting of the North Londonderry Township Board of Supervisors was called to order at 7:30 p.m. on February 20, 2024 by Chairman Ronald Fouché in the Township Municipal Building. Others attending were Supervisors Barry Riegle and William Buckfelder, Solicitor Andrew Morrow, Manager Michael Booth, Assistant Manager Kristopher Troup, Chief Kevin Snyder, and Secretary/Treasurer Lisa Daubert. Four (4) visitors were present.

Chairman Fouché called for questions or comments from the public on the agenda items for this meeting. None were received.

Minutes from the previous meeting, January 2, 2024 were approved as presented on motion by Riegle, seconded by Buckfelder. All in favor.

The Treasurer's Report for periods ending December 31, 2023 and January 31, 2024 were accepted as presented. All in favor.

The Police Reports for December 2023, 2023 Annual Police Report, and January 2024 were accepted as presented. All in favor. Chief Kevin Snyder noted the Police Reports have been placed on the Township's website and copies were placed in the Police Department's lobby for public viewing.

Manager Michael Booth reported the Planning Commission did not meet on February 20, 2024. Quorum was unavailable.

Manager Booth requested approval to expend approximately \$12,000 from the Capital Reserve Fund for the purchase of computers (\$4,500) and furniture (\$7,500) for the Police Department. On motion by Riegle, seconded by Buckfelder, the Supervisors approved the expending of \$12,000 from the Capital Reserve Fund as requested. All in favor.

On motion by Riegle, seconded by Buckfelder, the Supervisors made the following appointments. All in favor.

Invoices were approved as presented on motion by Riegle, seconded by Buckfelder. All in favor.

Resolution No. 02-20-2024 (Lebanon County 2023 Hazard Mitigation Plan) was adopted on motion by Buckfelder, seconded by Riegle. All in favor.

Alex Kinzey, Steckbeck Engineering & Associates in Lebanon, presented a final subdivision plan from Brian McCurdy. The Supervisors reviewed the Final Subdivision Plan and Sewer Planning Module for a three (3) lot subdivision owned by Brian McCurdy. On motion by Buckfelder, seconded by Riegle, the Supervisors granted approval for the McCurdy Final Subdivision Plan and Sewer Planning Module. All in favor.

In her absence, Deborah Buckfelder, Township Representative – Palmyra Public Library Board submitted a monthly report noting an increase of 5.29% in circulation from December of 2022. Chairman Fouché gave a brief synopsis of the report. A copy is on file for public viewing.

There being no other business, the meeting adjourned at 7:54 p.m.
