

NORTH LONDONDERRY TOWNSHIP

BOARD OF SUPERVISORS

March 18, 2024

The regular meeting of the North Londonderry Township Board of Supervisors was called to order on March 18, 2024 at 7:30 p.m. by Chairman Ron Fouché in the Township Municipal Building. Present were Supervisors Barry Riegler and William Buckfelder, Solicitor Andrew Morrow, Manager Michael Booth, Assistant Manager Kristopher Troup, Chief Kevin Snyder, and Assistant Secretary/Treasurer Judy Miller. Four visitors were in attendance.

The Chairman called for questions or comments on the agenda items for this meeting. No comments were received.

Minutes from the meeting of February 20, 2024 were approved as presented on motion by Riegler, seconded by Buckfelder. All in favor.

The Treasurer's Report for the period ending February 29, 2024 was accepted as presented.

The Police Report for February 2024 was accepted as presented.

Manager Michael Booth reported the Planning Commission met March 18, 2024 and reviewed a Final Subdivision & Land Development Plan for Jordan T. Starner. The plan proposes a one lot subdivision off of Palmyra Bellegrove Road. The Planners are recommending the Board of Supervisors approve the plan.

Invoices were approved to be paid in a timely manner on motion by Buckfelder, seconded by Riegler. All in favor.

The Supervisors reviewed bids for the 2024 Highway Paving Program Contract. A motion was made by Riegler, seconded by Buckfelder to accept the low bid received from Penny Supply Inc. for a total bid price of \$305,199.20. All in favor.

The Supervisors reviewed the 2024 Sanitary Sewer Line Cleaning & Televising Contract bids. A motion was made by Buckfelder, seconded by Riegler to accept the low bid received from Pipe Services Corporation for a total bid price of \$42,100.80. All in favor.

On motion by Buckfelder, seconded by Riegler, the Supervisors approved the Final Subdivision & Land Development Plan for Jordan T. Starner. All in favor.

Deborah Buckfelder, Township Representative - Palmyra Public Library Board submitted a monthly report. Mrs. Buckfelder noted the spring fundraiser is "Titles &

Tumblers.” Patrons may choose a stainless steel tumbler and a book to dedicate in someone’s honor for \$40.00. Additional books and tumblers may be purchased separately.

There being no other business, the meeting was adjourned at 7:37 p.m.
