RAIN OR SHINE

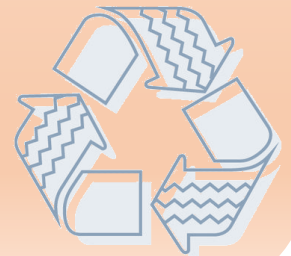
This event is open to all residents and businesses in the Palmyra Area School District. The drive-thru nature of the event allows you to leave after your documents are unloaded.

Where: Collected from your doorstep

When: Call or schedule online. (one collection per household per year) \$15 co-payment is required to schedule.

Electronic Recycling Facility

The Greater Lebanon Refuse Authority has an Electronic Recycling Facility located at 1805 Russell Road, Lebanon. This FREE service is available to all residents in Lebanon County. A wide variety of electronics are accepted, including printers, computers, TVs, keyboards, cables, smartphones, servers, and more! 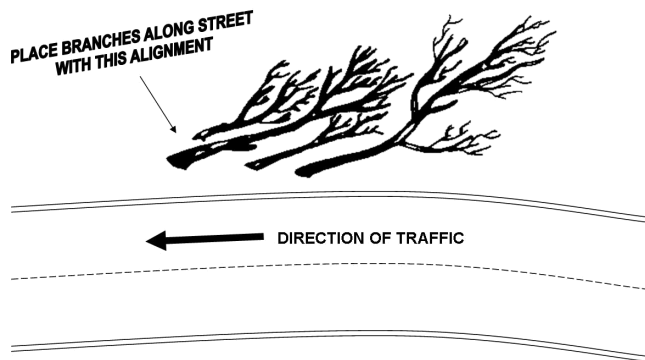
Rechargeable and single-use batteries are also accepted at the Electronic Recycling Facility. Each battery must be placed in an individual clear plastic storage/ziplock bag. Plastic bags are available for residents at the battery station. The Township also has a limited supply in the office if you'd prefer to bag batteries prior to your arrival at the GLRA.

Curbside Chipping

The first Monday of every month (except November and December) branches left curbside will be collected. There is no need to call or schedule. Crews make their way around the entire Township on collection day.

To participate, have your branches curbside by 7:00 a.m. the morning of collection. Do not put piles in the street or commingle branches with any other yard waste. Branches must be 1 to 3 inches in diameter and placed in a neat pile at the edge of your yard.

This collection is for routine maintenance performed by residents. Crews will not accept excessive trimmings or branches from tree take downs.



Did you know there are trails in the woods behind the Township building? Trails are maintained by the Township crew and open to the public from dawn to dusk. Dogs are welcome but must be leashed and picked up after. Enjoy time relaxing at one of the benches or picnic tables. The pond is open for catch and release fishing.
