PARKING AREA

CLOSED

The parking area for the trails by the Compost Facility, will be closed until further notice. Residents seeking to use the trails should either park in the Township Office parking lot, or the parking area by the pond.

Greater Lebanon Refuse Authority

The GLRA provides additional recycling services for Lebanon County residents including electronic and battery recycling. Residents can recycle mobile phones, computers, printers and more for FREE at the Electronic Recycling Facility at 1805 Russell Road, Lebanon.

The facility features a designated area for recycling rechargeable and single-use batteries. Each individual battery must be placed in a clear plastic bag. The GLRA has plastic bags available at the battery recycling station for residents using this program.

CURBSIDE CHIPPING

The Township's monthly chipping program will continue through October on the first Monday of the month. To participate, branches must be in your yard along the curb by 7:00 a.m. on collection day.

Chipping will resume in January. Christmas trees will be collected on any scheduled collection day. Remove **all** decorations prior to placing trees curbside.

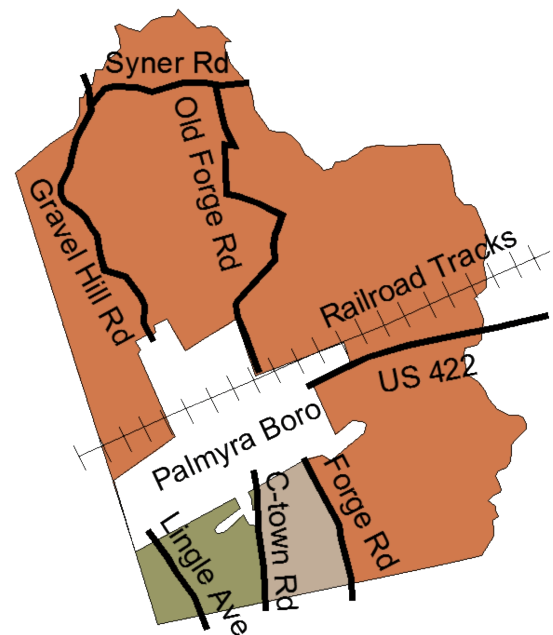
Fall Leaf Collection


October 13 to December 12


There is no need to call to schedule a pickup. Anyone residing on a street dedicated to the Township can utilize this free service. For safety reasons, services can not be conducted on Gravel Hill Road, Route 422, or South Forge Road from Park Drive south to the Township Line. To participate, place leaves in the street along the curb in long narrow piles by 7:00 a.m. on your scheduled collection day. Residents without a curb should keep them on their property, but as close to the road as possible, without interfering with traffic.

Crews will not return to any street they have already serviced. Remember this is a weekly service over the course of nine weeks. If your leaves are not out in time for collection, crews will be around the following week. If you see a leaf truck on your street before your collection day, don't fret! Crews often work ahead to keep up with the volume of leaves. They will still pass through on the scheduled day, weather permitting. We ask for your patience as unforeseen equipment issues or inclement weather could occasionally cause crews to run behind schedule.

****This service is for leaves ONLY.** Piles containing grass, sticks, pine cones, or other garden residue will be left behind. ******

COMPOST FACILITY

You may notice construction underway near the Compost Facility. Due to an increase in yard waste recycling throughout the Township, the Compost Facility is expanding! Residents with a compost card will continue to have access to the site and be able to use it as usual.

Compost Facility hours of operation for **November** through **March** are as follows:

Monday - Saturday 7:00 a.m. - 5:00 p.m.

Sunday 12:00 noon - 5:00 p.m.

All access passes for the Compost Facility will expire on December 31. Remember to keep your card! Passes may be renewed in the office anytime after January 1.

HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE

Do you have old paint, automotive products, lawn chemicals, or household cleaners? The GLRA sponsors an at home collection of household hazardous waste for all Lebanon County residents. How does it work?

Step 1 - Request a collection.

Your request can be made by phone at 1-800-742-5542 Ext.123 or online at www.mxiinc.com/lebanon/. After providing the necessary information, you will be required to submit your \$15 co-payment in order to move on.

Step 2 - Schedule for collection.

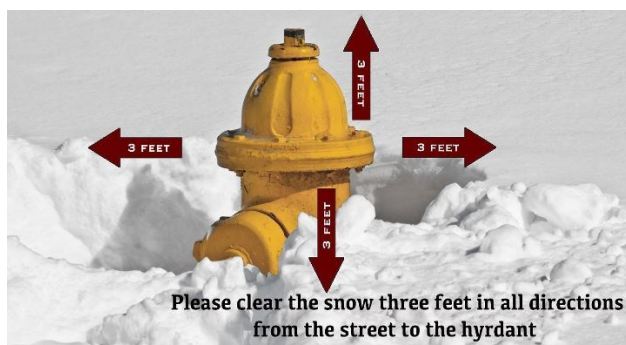
A pickup day will be scheduled on the next available collection day. A Household Hazardous Waste Kit will be mailed to your home prior to your collection date. All materials must fit inside the kit.

Step 3 - Collection pick up.

On your scheduled collection date, you will place the HHW Kit on your doorstep by 7:00 a.m. MXI Environmental Services Inc. will collect the eligible waste materials directly from your doorstep.
