

NORTH LONDONDERRY TOWNSHIP COMPOST FACILITY RULES AND REGULATIONS 2026

HOURS OF OPERATION:

APRIL through OCTOBER
Monday - Saturday 7:00 a.m. - 8:00 p.m.
Sunday 12:00 noon - 8:00 p.m.

NOVEMBER through MARCH
Monday - Saturday 7:00 a.m. - 5:00 p.m.
Sunday 12:00 noon - 5:00 p.m.

1. Upon the receipt of an annual fee and the completion of the necessary application, a North Londonderry Township resident will be issued a key card for permitted drop off privileges and access to the facility during the above noted time periods.
2. Key cards may **ONLY** be used by the property owner or an immediate family member living at their residence. The card is **NOT** transferable. Anyone using the card, other than the individual(s) issued the card, will constitute banning the permittee from use of the facility.
3. The site is available for **residential users only - no commercial, industrial or institutional dumping is permitted. Only items from the resident's property may be deposited at this site.**
4. Items permitted at the site are to be placed non-commingled in the clearly marked bins. Bagging, boxing, or tying of items is prohibited. Containers/buckets are not to be left at the facility.
5. Individuals found violating facility rules & regulations are subject to having their privileges and key card revoked. Dumping of unacceptable items or use by an unpermitted individual is classified as "illegal dumping" and will be strictly enforced by the North Londonderry Township Police Department.
6. No smoking inside the compost facility.
7. The Township reserves the right to require and ask vehicle operators using the compost site to provide proof of identity, vehicle insurance and address of residency within the Township.
8. Individuals using the compost facility who cause damage to property or whose actions lead to the personal injury of crews and/or others using the facility shall be held liable.
