

Place your leaves in long narrow piles in the street along the curb, leaving space for rainwater to flow to catch basins. Piles should be at least 15 feet from any parked car, intersection, or basketball net to allow equipment space to operate. Remove all pine cones, sticks, etc. from leaf piles. Leaves should be prepared as instructed by 7:00 a.m. on your collection day.



Crews will collect branches from 1-3 inches in diameter as well as small shrubs. In order to be collected curbside, branches must be trimmed by the resident themselves, as a result of **routine maintenance**.

Excessive trimmings and branches from tree take downs will NOT be accepted. Branches must be placed in your yard along the curb by 7:00 a.m. on collection day. Do not commingle branches with any other yard waste. All root balls must be removed.
