


Calls for Service – Monthly Trend (YTD)

Training

- Officer Joel Weidner attended the Enforcement of Pennsylvania Vehicle Inspection Regulations course through the Institute for Law Enforcement Education (ILEE). The two-day class focused on enforcement of Pennsylvania vehicle inspection laws and certain sections of the Vehicle Code related to registration and equipment standards.

Administrative / Staffing Updates
